The North Dakota Winter Show is recruiting for a Building and Grounds employee. This person is responsible for overall routine maintenance of the ND Winter Show building and grounds, set up and tear down for various events held during the year. General carpentry, electricity & plumbing knowledge required. Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds regularly, must be able to run forklift, skid steer and other heavy equipment.

Ideal candidate will be self-motivated and a self starter, as many hours of work will be solo. Must be a critical thinker and able to multi-task, as some work requires dealing with multiple people, staff and problem solving.

Candidate is responsible for cleaning of grounds and event centers. Keeping arena and back barns watered for dust during events. Trash removal and clean up from entire property, indoors and out. Cleaning bleachers prior to, during and post events. Stall set up and tear down (storage) for events.

Multiple light duty requirements that can be discussed.

Requirements:

Valid driver's license.

Flexibility with work schedule. Some weekends and evenings are required to be on staff, based on events being held. Ability to supervise and direct staff. Able to take direction.

Livestock or agriculture background would be preferred but not required.

Approximately 40 hours per week. Flexible schedule with flexible hours, when needed. Evening and weekend overtime can be flexed off during work week and pay period. The main shows with overtime will be paid.
